He spoke of security measures we have in place for our schools. These would include the State sponsored "Say Something" Anonymous reporting, bomb threat protocols, spectator event bags, Mobile Command Vehicles, etc. We will also be deleting the word code red/yellow and adopt a standard response protocol which Mrs. Thomas already does.

Our second speaker spoke of gun safety, and making it easier to talk with other parents about making sure any guns are locked up when your child visits. In 2021 there were 4.6 million people living in a home with an unlocked loaded gun.
